

FREEDOM ENCOUNTERS DELIVERANCE APPROACH	TRADITIONAL DELIVERANCE APPROACHES
1. The FE approach provides a structured process designed to help the person grow spiritually and maintain their freedom/healing.	Involves a deliverance event that does not provide tools to help the person grow spiritually and maintain their freedom/healing.
2. During the ministry, total safety and protection are provided for the minister as well as the person receiving deliverance/healing.	Often those ministering, as well as those receiving deliverance, are harassed, embarrassed or battered by the demonic
3. The demonic structures, programming and devices are removed and destroyed. The person is sealed and safe from re-invasion.	The demonic structures remain even if the demons are removed. Future re-invasion is a strong probability.
4. The Head Demon in authority must reveal what the Lord Jesus Christ requires him to say about how the demonic worked to hinder and destroy the person's life.	A few demons are dealt with and may be held accountable for their work, but the Head Demon and other demonic spirits remain hidden to cause continued harassment.
5. Personality fractures called "Alters," that have resulted from trauma, are saved, cleansed, healed and integrated.	There is nothing done to help Alters; thus, on-going ministry will be required before inner healing can be achieved.
6. The person also receives prayer for physical and emotional healing.	Little or no attention is given to providing ministry to help the whole person.
7. The person's children, grandchildren and great grandchildren can also be set free in one deliverance prayer session.	Some demons may be removed if they are identified, but neither the person nor their children are set free.
8. This approach addresses the whole person: Body, Soul (mind, will, emotions) and Spirit. The result is freedom, healing and restoration at all levels.	This limited approach typically focuses on evil spirits and seeking outward behavioral change rather than providing ministry to bring inner transformational change.
9. Focus is given to reveal God-given spiritual gifts of a person, rather than to just removing evil. The Holy Spirit reveals the person's gifts, call, and destiny in the Kingdom of God	Nothing is done to reveal God-given gifts. The Holy Spirit is only asked to help remove the demonic.
10. Teaches that freedom and healing are provided by the power of God, but there is no "quick fix." The person must learn to stand in the authority of Christ and make personal choices to move forward in developing intimacy with Him.	Understands that healing is God's work, but a lack of knowledge that freedom /healing involves more than removing demon spirits sets the stage for failure and despair. Simply removing a few demons cannot eliminate a lifetime of demonic destruction.
11. The person is set free and filled with hope, healing, and a vision for life.	The person is rid of a few demons that may have been evident in his/her life.
12. We believe that the FE model is the most respectful and thorough ministry approach of its kind in the world today.	While this approach is piece-meal and often painful, it is still better than refusing to confront demonic realities at all.
